Lighting

- ☐ Replace traditional incandescent light bulbs with energy efficient LED light bulbs.
- ☐ Install dimmers, motion sensors or timers to control lighting in unoccupied areas.



Heating, Ventilation & Air Conditioning (HVAC)

- ☐ Schedule regular maintenance for HVAC systems to ensure optimal performance.
- ☐ Consider upgrading to energy-efficient HVAC systems.
- ☐ Consider installing programmable thermostats to efficiently regulate temperature during business hours.



Insulation

- ☐ Inspect the building for air leaks and seal them using weatherstripping or caulk.
- ☐ Improve insulation in walls, ceilings, and windows to minimise heat loss/gain



Appliances & Equipment

- ☐ Upgrade to energy efficient appliances with high Energy Star Ratings in break rooms or kitchens
